Commentary on April 5th

Born in a slave hut this day, April 5th, 1856, was Booker T. Washington. In dire poverty after the Civil War, he moved to West Virginia to work in a salt furnace and coal mine. At age 16 he walked nearly 500 miles to attend Hampton Institute. After graduation, he taught in West Virginia until he founded Tuskegee Institute in Alabama, where he recruited George Washington Carver as a professor. At his death, the school boasted of 1,500 students, and a faculty of 200 teaching 38 trades. The first

African American to have his image on a U.S. coin and postage stamp, Booker T. Washington wrote in his book, Up From Slavery (1907): "If no other consideration had convinced me of the value of the Christian life, the Christlike work which the Church of all denominations in

America has done during the last thirty-five years for the elevation of the black man would have made me a Christian."
